

The Secret Meaning of the Gospels...

When the Roman Emperor Constantine came to power in 306 CE, he soon chose to favour a new faith emerging in the Empire: Christianity. By the end of the fourth century Christianity had become the dominant religion in the Roman world. The scriptures on which it was based were translated to Latin and the gospel narrative, presented as history, was interpreted to serve the needs of imperial authority. The riddles and secrets of the original Greek scriptures were lost to Constantine, the bishops of the church and those they sought to lead.

For twelve centuries the Catholic Church held sway across Europe. Then, in the fifteenth century, the invention of printing triggered the Protestant Reformation, unleashing a fresh bout of translations from scripture and further obscuring the mysteries of the original Greek texts. That which was misunderstood in the era of Constantine was misunderstood afresh.

For three hundred years the Protestant churches would now contend with Rome. Then, in the nineteenth century, Charles Darwin's book *The Origin of Species* sent shockwaves throughout the Christian world by explaining the mechanism for evolution. The churches reconsidered their long-held claim for the historicity of the creation story found in the book of Genesis. Few now considered that creation in six days was a tenable thesis. And it was clear that the world was around one million times older than Constantine's church had taught for so long.

While coming to terms with Genesis as myth, the Christian churches continued to treat the gospels and New Testament letters as records of real events and persons. Among theologians a movement now emerged that understood Jesus not so much as divine but more as a historical person: 'Jesus the Jew'. Yet still, as the second millennium came to an end, no-one realised that there was something fundamentally wrong with Christianity itself.

The author's insightful analysis of the primary Greek scriptures shows how the ancient mysteries may be solved. In this remarkable book, the secrets of the Greek Bible are rediscovered and the gospels recognised for what they really are.
